AFTERNOON BEFORE PROCEDURE:

- 1. Eat a regular diet.
- 2. Nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night before procedure.
- **MORNING OF PROCEDURE:**
- 1. Nothing to eat or drink.
- 2. You may take your morning blood pressure and heart medications with just a sip of water.
 - You will need a driver 18 years or older to take you home. You will NOT be allowed to drive
 - Or work the day of your test. Your driver must be here 1 ½ hours after your scheduled procedure time.
 - o Bring a list of medications with dosages, your health insurance information, and photo ID.
 - Please inform our office prior to your procedure if you have a latex allergy.
 - Do not take any blood thinning medication 5 days before your test. This includes:
 - Coumadin, Plavix, Pradaxa, Effient, Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Aleve. If you take medications for arthritis please check with the nurse about taking your medications. If you have had a heart stent placed in the last year, please contact our office before discontinuing any blood thinner. Tylenol is ok if you need to take a pain reliever.
 - If you take an evening dose of insulin, take only one half of your regular dose. Hold your insulin the morning of the procedure until after your procedure.
