

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From North I-15

- · Take exit 304 to merge onto I-80 E toward Cheyenne
- · Take exit 125 for 700 East
- · Turn RIGHT at 700 East
- · Turn LEFT at 3900 South
- · Turn RIGHT into hospital

From East-Belt of I-215

- · Take exit 4 for 3900 South
- \cdot Turn WEST, follow signs for 3900 South
- · Merge onto 3900 South
- · Travel approximately 4.28 miles
- · Turn LEFT into hospital

From South I-15

- · Take exit 301 for 4500 South toward State Highway 266
- · Keep RIGHT at the fork, follow signs for Murray
- · Turn RIGHT at 4500 South/Taylorsville Expressway/UT-266
- · Turn LEFT at State Street/Highway 89
- · Turn RIGHT at 3900 South
- \cdot Turn RIGHT into hospital

Visiting Hours

A patient's family or friends may visit the patient at any time provided the patient's condition can accommodate visits, and that the visitor's conduct does not interfere with the care and comfort of other patients. Children may not be unattended while visiting patients. Certain areas within the hospital, such as ICU and NICU, have specific visiting guidelines unique to their area.

The hospital's main doors are locked from 10:00 PM - 5:00 AM. During those times visitors must enter and exit the main hospital through the Emergency Department doors at the Central Medical Office Building.

Security

Chaplain Services

St. Mark's Hospital provides multi-faith chaplaincy services 24 hours a day 7 days a week. 
