

At HCA East Florida, we are the largest provider of healthcare services across South Florida with over 1,000,000 patient encounters, 615,000 emergency room visits, 15 hospital campuses, 7 free-standing emergency rooms, 12 ambulatory surgery centers and 105 physician practices. Our caregivers and support staff are committed to providing an excellent experience for every patient and caregiver, every time.

This has never been more apparent than in the past year during the COVID-19 pandemic. This pivotal year tested everyone both within our facilities and across the world. Despite the challenges we faced, our top priority was protecting our people so they could continue providing excellent care to our patients. HCA East Florida treated more than 15,000 COVID-19 patients in 2020—the most of any Division within the company.

Due to support from HCA Healthcare, we were able to protect our colleagues by ensuring they had adequate personal protective equipment (PPE) and provide services such as scrub laundering and complimentary hotel accommodations for those who did not want to expose their families to COVID-19. We also implemented and expanded a number of programs including pandemic pay and quarantine pay. In addition, we introduced new programs to support the mental health and wellbeing of our colleagues.

We are deeply grateful for how our teams have risen to meet the historic challenges of this year while providing care to our communities. Even during a pandemic, our culture of Excellence ALWAYS has continued to elevate the care and experience we provide to our patients, colleagues and physicians.




Providing Adequate PPE

To minimize COVID-19 exposure and preserve PPE, we appoint PPE stewards to help ensure clinicians have the protective equipment they need and with an accurate fit in order to keep them safe.

In 2020, HCA East Florida distributed over 122,563,427 units of PPE to our hospitals and surgery centers. The creation of PPE depots in all of our hospitals helped create clarity and reassurance for our staff. These depots created accessibility and highlighted an emphasis on appropriate utilization to ensure that our caregivers were protected with the right PPE.

Government supplies were requested and secured to support additional needs in the hospitals. These supplies were reviewed and approved for use by clinical leadership before going out to our teams. Tools were created in PowerBI to help monitor available inventory on hand in our warehouses. From this tool, we were able to support transfers to and from HCA warehouses across the country to protect our team and keep stock levels appropriate to meet the need.



Partnering With Our Physicians

Throughout the pandemic in 2020, we worked closely with our physicians to understand their needs and provide support for their practices by helping create a safe and protected patient care environment.

To address medical practice or business disruption, HCA Healthcare granted rent deferral with owned medical office buildings (MOBs). This helped to maintain availability of medical care and related businesses and services for patients and the community ("COVID-19 purposes") as permitted by federal waivers.

We connected physicians with experts to do live Q&A sessions during our physician confidence and resiliency webinar support series. Additionally, division-wide town halls were held with CEOs, CNOs, and CMOs for primary care, surgeons and rural facility partners to share information and understand needs related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Through HCA CARES, HCA Healthcare provided education to physicians regarding the CARES Act, including a website and hotline, for COVID-19 purposes as permitted by federal waivers.

We are happy to share that we currently rank second in all of HCA Healthcare in physician satisfaction. We are working to exceed our physicians' expectations including deepening our services and attracting and retaining top talent for our programs. HCA East Florida partnered with local, state and federal health officials to ensure that all appropriate infection control guidelines and protocols that were being followed were shared with our providers. Additionally, we hosted town halls with community and affiliate providers to assist with COVID-19 resources such as telehealth and online appointment scheduling.

Graduate Medical Education Program

From the moment a graduate joins an HCA Healthcare residency or fellowship, they are mentored by a dynamic network of physicians who are focused on teaching them to provide the exceptional, compassionate care our patients deserve. HCA East Florida currently has 36 Graduate Medical Education (GME) Programs with 516 Students. Our GME students are enrolled in a variety of programs such as Cardiovascular, Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, Podiatry, and Pulmonary to name a few.

These programs are led by an accomplished faculty, set under rigorous standards, and tailored to provide extensive training for the next generation of physician leaders.

When the COVID-19 pandemic struck Florida, Courtney took advantage of the hotel benefits made available through HCA Healthcare so that she could continue serving the community.

According to Courtney, "My 15-year-old daughter Isabella has Osteogenesis Imperfecta, 'Brittle Bone Disease', and had just finished an outof-state treatment when I received the call that my floor had turned into a COVID-19 unit. My daughter's treatments make her immunocompromised, and I couldn't risk bringing home the virus to her and my son, Nicholas. I also knew that I had to go to work because nursing is my passion. It was my duty to jump in during this crisis, and I am also a single mother. HR worked with me to get a hotel the same day I came back from my daughter's treatment, where I stayed for a two week stretch, as well as a month long stretch of time. I am so grateful that HCA Healthcare stepped up to help me care for our patients suffering from COVID-19, while also making sure my children were safe back home."

Being There For Our Patients

Given ongoing recommended precautions by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), we adjusted our facilities to help keep patients, colleagues and visitors safe throughout the pandemic by implementing several new safety protocols and processes.

HCA East Florida closely monitored CDC guidelines and began limiting visitation, performing temperature checks and screenings for cold and flu like symptoms prior to entry and implemented universal masking of all visitors and colleagues throughout the facility at all times.

In response to the needs of our community, an additional 821 new nurses were hired to assist in taking care of our patients. Additionally, we setup vaccine clinics for all colleagues, physicians and first responders, and offered vaccines to our new colleagues as they came on board. In total, 10,087 staff members had been vaccinated as of December 31, 2020. We had a dedicated Clinical Operations Team made up of Division Clinical leaders and Supply Chain that closely monitored CDC guidance allowing us to validate and appropriately rollout education to the facilities to reduce variation and risk. HCA East Florida used HCA Healthcare's scale to ensure there was an adequate supply of PPE, ventilators and medications for our patients.



EVERFI

In October, HCA Healthcare announced a collaboration with EVERFI, an international technology company driving social change through education, to launch an interactive, digital mental health and wellness education course for middle and high school students. Called Mental Wellness Basics, the course has already reached more than 12,000 middle and high school students in an estimated 105 school districts. HCA Healthcare is investing nearly \$1 million over the next three years to sponsor the course. In HCA East Florida, we were proud to partner with 8 schools and 441 students.

Step Up for Students Program

HCA East Florida has historically supported Step Up For Students, a program created to help alleviate the enormous educational challenges faced by children in low-income Florida families. In 2020, HCA Healthcare contributed \$44,500,000 to the Step Up for Students program, which funded nearly 6,298 scholarships. Since the program begin in 2005, HCA Healthcare has contributed \$232,375,000 and funded over 42,600 scholarships.

Continuing our commitment to the Step Up For Students program, in 2020 HCA Healthcare offered more than \$1 million in corporate income tax to the Step Up For Students program, which provides unique scholarships to low-income Florida students pursing their education.

HCA East Florida is proud to serve our Broward. Miami-Dade, Palm Beach and the Treasure Coast communities and we are committed to investing in them for years to come.

HCA Healthcare has not laid-off a single employee due to the pandemic, and in April 2020, it instituted a pandemic pay program, which allowed the organization to continue to pay more than 127,000 colleagues, even when their hours were affected by the significant decrease in patients visiting hospitals across the country.

Additionally, HCA East Florida Division, provided \$150,000 in grant support to the United Ways of Miami-Dade and Broward counties. The one-time grants of \$50,000 and \$100,000 have been distributed to community partners that are focused on the COVID-19 emergency response and food banks, including:

The COVID-19 pandemic was at the forefront of 2020 and HCA Healthcare responded by protecting its colleagues and patients, and by partnering with others to improve care beyond

HCA East Florida is dedicated to ensuring equitable access to high quality care for our patients, fostering a diverse and inclusive workplace for our colleagues, and cultivating and sustaining relationships with suppliers and community partners that broaden our reach and deepen our understanding in the communities we serve.

In response to a heightened focus on racial injustice, HCA Healthcare instituted a provisional social justice match, which supported gifts from colleagues to organizations and nonprofits supporting racial justice and addressing health equity for communities of color. In total, HCA Healthcare and its colleagues helped make an impact of \$227,364 across 21 total organizations from June 5 to July 31, 2020.

In 2020, HCA Healthcare announced its second annual national "Crush the Crisis" event to raise awareness about the dangers of opioid misuse and proper disposal of medications.



HCA East Florida works with HCA Healthcare's Sarah Cannon Cancer Institute. As part of this relationship, patients may have access to nurse navigation and clinical trials. Sarah Cannon affiliated facilities also benefit to access from national and internal experts on cancer care.

In addition to Commission on Cancer accreditation, JFK Hospital's Breast Institute is accredited by the National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers.

Ambulatory Surgery Centers

Our twelve Ambulatory Surgery Centers were founded to provide our patients and physicians with the finest quality of outpatient care, delivered in a compassionate and efficient manner. Our physicians are supported by a highly skilled team of registered nurses and surgical technicians specially trained in surgical and recovery care. The standards of care required by Medicare and other regulatory bodies are strictly adhered to.

Our surgery centers are accredited by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care. We have six centers in Miami-Dade County, two in Broward County, three in Palm Beach County and one in St. Lucie County.

Patient Transfer Center

The mission of the South Florida Transfer Center is to facilitate timely patient transfers, ensuring all patients receive the right level of care when expertise and efficiency are critical. In 2020, the South Florida Transfer Center managed 444,500 phone calls, 33,000 patient movements and 31,200 transports.

With a call to the South Florida Transfer Center, you will reach the right hospital and service for your patients' needs for hospital-to-hospital transfers.

Calls are handled 24/7 by Registered Nurses and Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) knowledgeable on the Emergency Medical Treatment and Labor Act (EMTALA).

Call schedules for every HCA facility in HCA East Florida are visible to the Transfer Center nurses and technicians, ensuring accurate service line availability in the HCA Healthcare network of facilities.

HCA East Florida launched its first trauma program in 2009. That means access to specially trained trauma surgeons, orthopedic surgeons, neurosurgeons, anesthesiologists, radiologists and emergency medicine specialists is available around the clock. In 2020, HCA East Florida treated 8,500 trauma patients. Our trauma centers span from Fort Pierce to Miami and include:

Treasure Coast Trauma at Lawnwood Hospital, designated as a Level II Trauma Center by the Florida Department of Health and verified by the American College of Surgeons.

South Florida Trauma at Kendall Hospital, a Level I Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center Certified by the Florida Department of Health and verified as a Level I Adult Trauma Center by the American College of Surgeons.


The Trauma Center at Aventura Hospital, designated as a Level II Trauma Center by the Florida Department of Health.

Our trauma programs partner with one of the state's premier medical schools to establish the University of South Florida/ HCA Trauma Network. This partnership enables HCA East Florida trauma programs to meet goals for research, quality, safety and better outcomes for patients. Florida residents benefit from centralized, statewide data collection for trauma research and coordination of services not readily accessible in underserved areas of the state.

Orthopedic and Spine Care

Our network of hospitals offers patients access to a full spectrum of orthopedic and spine services for accurate diagnosis and treatment. From conservative measures and pain management to minimally invasive or complex procedures, our hospitals offer an integrated model of care to help patients get back to their everyday activities as quickly and safely as possible.

HCA East Florida's orthopedic programs span from joint replacement and sports medicine to orthopedic oncology. We leverage progressive technology to advance our clinical programs and offer minimally invasive robotic surgery to promote faster recovery.






