

COVID-19 Response

With each COVID-19 wave, HCA East Florida streamlined operations, learned new clinical skills and implemented programs that help fight the virus. We targeted wage adjustments to ensure competitive rates and worked hand-in-hand with supply chain to ensure personal protective equipment and essential equipment was provided for all colleagues. Additionally, we revamped recruiting practices and incentive activities to assist with getting our colleagues the support they needed.



Innovations For Care and Research


As part of HCA Healthcare's learning health system, HCA East Florida is connected to more resources, more solutions and more possibilities for everyone who walks through our doors.

HCA Healthcare has invested significantly in clinical education, including:

Nursing Schools: HCA Healthcare owns Galen College of Nursing, one of the largest educators of nurses in the United States, with six campuses and nearly 8,000 students enrolled in the January 2021 term. HCA Healthcare, which employs more than 93,000 nurses, has two additional nursing schools, Research College of Nursing and Mercy School of Nursing.

HCA Healthcare Centers for Clinical Advancement: HCA Healthcare has seven Centers for Clinical Advancement across the country that provide nurses and clinicians with state-of-the-art simulation and learning centers to expand their clinical knowledge in a safe and supportive environment. This includes the newly opened HCA East Florida Center for Clinical Advancement in Plantation, Florida.

Clinical Certifications: HCA Healthcare also supports colleagues who want to obtain specialty clinical certifications by paying upfront testing costs, providing test preparation materials and reimbursing costs after successful completion of a certification exam. Colleagues also receive bonuses for achieving nationally recognized certifications beyond their current position.



Education and Development Resources

HCA Healthcare is proud to support the educational goals of our colleagues and their family members through a variety of programs.

Vital Voices

Ensuring a positive and inclusive colleague experience starts by giving each of our 17,062 colleagues a chance to share their thoughts in a confidential format. HCA Healthcare sends an onboarding pulse survey to colleagues after 45 and 100 days of employment to receive feedback on the onboarding and recruitment experience. Vital Voices engagement pulse surveys are shared throughout the year to help our teams set goals and make improvements. Not only does this lead to a better experience for our colleagues, but also better care for our patients.

Colleague Networks

HCA Healthcare has established enterprise-wide, virtual networks to give colleagues the chance to meet and network with peers who have shared experiences and commonalities. So far, seven Colleague Networks have been created for veterans, Black colleagues, women, young professionals, LGBTQ+ colleagues, Hispanic/Latinx colleagues, and Asian and Pacific Islander colleagues – each with a senior leader serving as executive sponsor.

Mental Wellness

We are here to support our physicians, nurses and other colleagues so they can continue to provide the superior, patient-centered care our communities deserve.

Nurse Care: This free, confidential, 24/7 support program and counseling service gives HCA Healthcare full-time and part-time hospital-based nurses remote access to licensed psychologists, social workers and marriage and family therapists. In 2021, 24,720 calls were received across the HCA Healthcare enterprise.

Optum: This partnership offers colleagues and members of their immediate household up to five free counseling sessions per topic each year. Colleagues can also access free apps, resources and referral services to find help with anything from home maintenance to legal support.

Motivation Alliance: HCA Healthcare colleagues can access a free custom version of this service, which provides tools for managing stress and anxiety.


Doctor on Demand: Colleagues with an eligible HCA Healthcare medical plan can speak with a board-certified physician any time, day or night, through this telehealth service. Physicians provide care for 90% of the most common health conditions, including stress, anxiety and depression.

Community Partnerships

HCA East Florida is honored to partner with organizations that share our mission and values in caring for our community. Highlighted below are a few organizations we aligned with in 2021.

Gilda's Club was awarded \$126,000 over two years to support cancer care services in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties. Program highlights include outreach to people of color impacted by cancer and those with limited access to health education and resources.

Cultural proficiency and competency is an important element in providing high-quality health care and preventive services to diverse populations, especially in the setting of cancer care. Gilda's Club South Florida initiated the Health Equity Matters initiative, recognizing systemic racism, health disparities, and the disproportionate negative impact of COVID on communities of color.

"The HCA Healthier Tomorrow Fund has allowed Gilda's Club South Florida to provide cancer support and mental health services to the Spanish-speaking community in South Florida to ensure that Latinos, as part of this initiative, are receiving more opportunities for high-level cancer care," says Kim Praitano, Gilda's Club, CEO.

Pace Center for Girls received \$10,000 to fund the Pace Pathways to Healthcare Careers Program. This initiative exposes girls of diverse backgrounds to careers in the healthcare industry through field trips, seminars and a mentoring program.

American Red Cross

HCA Healthcare shares a long history of partnering with the American Red Cross to provide disaster relief. In 2021, HCA Healthcare made a third consecutive \$500,000 contribution to the American Red Cross Annual Disaster Giving Program. Over the last five years, HCA Healthcare has provided more than \$4.6 million in financial support to the Red Cross for shared disaster response capabilities and relief efforts. We also provide Red Cross leaders with access to our emergency response information system to help coordinate their activities.

Supporting Mental Health Education with EVERFI

As a learning health system, HCA Healthcare understands the important role that early education can play in addressing the mental wellbeing of kids and adolescents. HCA Healthcare is proud to have partnered with EVERFI, an international technology company driving social change through education, to launch *Mental Wellness Basics*, a digital resource that introduces middle and high school students to mental health education. Starting in 2021, HCA Healthcare has committed to investing \$3 million over the next three years to EVERFI to support and expand the Mental Wellness Basics course.

 Since its launch in October 2020, the Mental Wellness Basics course has reached more than 18,000 middle and high school students at 155 schools across the country.

March of Dimes

HCA Healthcare is the largest system for delivering babies in the country and more than 217,000 babies are delivered at our hospitals every year. Together, March of Dimes and HCA Healthcare are uniquely positioned to use their combined clinical data, pioneering research and passionate history to deliver healthier tomorrows for mothers and babies.

A Workforce Reflecting the Communities We Serve

HCA Healthcare's first gift to a Hispanic Serving Institution was awarded to Florida International University (FIU).

In April 2022, representatives from HCA Healthcare, HCA East Florida Division and HCA Florida Healthcare presented Florida International University (FIU) with a \$1.5 million donation to support the Nicole Wertheim College of Nursing & Health Sciences to expand its faculty and offer scholarships to increase enrollment and address the national nursing shortage.

HCA Healthcare has a history of partnering with organizations to develop future healthcare leaders. The College received funding as part of HCA Healthcare's support of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSIs). FIU is a federally-designated Hispanic and Minority Serving Institution with a student body that is 61 percent Hispanic.

Combating the Opioid Crisis

In October 2021, HCA Healthcare hosted its third annual *Crush the Crisis* event, collecting a record **15,566 pounds** of unused and expired medications in support of the Drug Enforcement Administration's National Prescription Take Back Day. In partnership with local law enforcement agencies, collection sites were set up at **96** HCA Healthcare facilities at **98** event locations across **17** states.

HCA East Florida successfully collected
479 pounds across 4 facilities. HCA Florida
Northwest Hospital partnered with
Walgreens to co-host their local *Crush the Crisis* event in Margate. This partnership has since developed into a broader opportunity for other HCA East Florida Division facilities to work with Walgreens stores in the communities to support opioid reduction and awareness efforts.

Environmental Stewardship

As stewards of the environment, we proactively make our communities healthier. We have implemented environmentally friendly practices at all hospitals, promoting conservation, decreasing waste, and exercising environmentally conscious purchasing. By using Stericycle's Sharps Management Service, HCA East Florida Division is significantly reducing its carbon footprint

In 2021, HCA East Florida was able to prevent 221,687 pounds of CO2 emissions, while also preventing 373,572 pounds of plastic and 28,951 pounds of cardboard out of entering our landfills. In total HCA East Florida recycled over 1,443,000 pounds of trash.



"HCA Healthcare and FIU have enjoyed a longstanding partnership," said Charles Gressle, HCA East Florida Division President. "This donation will allow FIU to grow their curriculum and offer scholarships to those answering the call to help prepare more of Florida's nurses; they are the backbone of our hospitals, and our communities and patients benefit from their strength and resilience."







Trauma Centers

Timely access to trauma centers ensures those experiencing traumatic injury have the best chance at recovery.

HCA East Florida launched its first trauma program in 2009. That means access to specially trained trauma surgeons, orthopedic surgeons, neurosurgeons, anesthesiologists, radiologists and emergency medicine specialists is available around the clock. In 2020, HCA East Florida treated 8,500 trauma patients. Our trauma centers span from Fort Pierce to Miami and include:

Treasure Coast Trauma at HCA Florida Lawnwood Hospital,

designated as a Level II Trauma Center by the Florida Department of Health and verified by the American College of Surgeons.

South Florida Trauma at HCA Florida Kendall Hospital, a Level I Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center Certified by the Florida Department of Health and verified as a Level I Adult Trauma Center by the American College of Surgeons.


The Trauma Center at HCA Florida Aventura Hospital, designated as a Level II Trauma Center by the Florida Department of Health.

Our trauma programs partner with one of the state's premier medical schools to establish the University of South Florida/ HCA Trauma Network. This partnership enables HCA East Florida trauma programs to meet goals for research, quality, safety and better outcomes for patients. Florida residents benefit from centralized, statewide data collection for trauma research and coordination of services not readily accessible in underserved areas of the state.

Orthopedic and Spine Care

Our network of hospitals offers patients access to a full spectrum of orthopedic and spine services for accurate diagnosis and treatment. From conservative measures and pain management to minimally invasive or complex procedures, our hospitals offer an integrated model of care to help patients get back to their everyday activities as quickly and safely as possible.

HCA East Florida's orthopedic programs span from joint replacement and sports medicine to orthopedic oncology. We leverage progressive technology to advance our clinical programs and offer minimally invasive robotic surgery to promote faster recovery.

Women's Health





Physical Rehabilitation




